Peter Huth (49) is a leading police director and the director of the policetechnology unit within the Ministry of the Interior for the state of Hesse.

Since 2001, Peter Huth has been accountable for all state police force technology and its strategic alignment. Within this role, he is responsible for the successful implementation of numerous projects as well as the initiation and development of appropriate interstate cooperation partnerships.

Peter Huth is represented on several national committees, including the Subcommittee for Information Technology and Strategy (UA IuK), of which he is the deputy chairman. He chairs the Information and Communication Architecture and Standards Commission, one of four commissions affiliated with the UA IuK. This commission includes representatives from all states as well as the federal level, and develops and agrees nationwide architecture and standardisation schemes as well as promoting collaborative opportunities at a state and federal level.

The IPCC (INPOL-Land POLAS Competence Centre) was founded following the successive development of interstate cooperation in several constellations. Peter Huth has directed this unit since its inception in 2003 on behalf of the states Baden-Württemberg, Brandenburg, Hamburg and Hessen. The IPCC is a network cooperation enabling the functional and technical coordination of ongoing police software development between up to 14 participants. Current development within the IPCC network focuses on:

- INPOL-Land / POLAS (state versions of the police tracing system INPOL)
- ED-DI (digital police records)
- Mpol (mobile information retrieval systems)
- Access components e.g. to the central foreigner registry, the Motor Vehicle Agency, the VISA information system, a vehicle manufacturer database and citizen registration data
- Crime (Case management and analysis software)
- PKS (Software for the capture, maintenance and reporting of police criminal statistics)

Mr Huth is both an advocate for and a driver of cross-portfolio and interstate collaboration as well as for the establishment and ongoing development of corresponding cooperation partnerships.
