



#### What is G8 ?: General

#### <u>problems</u>

→ World Population: ca. 6.7 Billion people

→ G8 countries: ca. 850 million people



→ Monopoly of the course of the world on the initiative of the 8 biggest countries

## And what else do the G8 countries do?

- They do nearly 90 % of all global weapons trade.
- They produce 47% of the global CO<sub>2</sub> emissions.
- They control most "Third World" debt.
- 80% of medical patents are made from G8 countries, including patents for many AIDS drugs.
- They acount for 60% of global military expenses.



- Basic daily needs
  - food, shelter, clothing, medical aid, etc.
- Welfare support
  - pension and other public aid
- Direct actions & protests
- Cultural gatherings









## Community Kitchens

- everyday at several places in Tokyo and metropolitan areas
- homeless support groups, church groups, etc.
  - food service / medical consultation
  - information exchange (e.g. governmental policies towards the homeless action plans)
  - cultural events (e.g. movie screenings)





# Convergence centres or Camps

**Tokyo:** Convergence Centers (Irregular Rhythm Asylum and one in Koenji Area); Inexpensive Accommodation (€ 10-12) in Sanya area and limited amount of private homes

Osaka and Kyoto: Convergence Centers (somewhere); Inexpensive Accommodation (€ 10-12) in Kamagasaki area and limited amount of private homes

**Sapporo:** Convergence Center; Camp (one can stay with sleeping bag and tent, with vegan food); Inexpensive Accommodation (€ 15); Independent Media Center

Near Lake Toya: Camp and Independent Media Center

#### Japanese government innovated US-VISIT...

## Japanese police behavior


- Weapons they carry:
  - truncheons, plastic shields, sand-stuffed gloves
  - water cannon, tear gas
- In the situation of direct action:
  - Mass-arrests are uncommon
- Japanese police are not as violent as European's
- Authority's action against protestors:
  - Media has reported...

## Legal Advice

- Multi-language leaflets and web-site of legal advice will be available
- Basically keep Silent. But for foreign activists, we suggest to carry passport and reveal their minimum identity.
- Detention is generally for 3 days, with possible extension of 10 days, plus additional 10 days. Maximum 23 days.

# Significance of the anti-G8 movement as the only Asian country of the G8, Japan

- G8 in a society of high consumerism and control
- Rethinking of Japanese imperialism and its continuation
- The appearance of the anti- or alterglobalisation movement in East Asia
- Creation of international solidarity from an Asian country
